Fr. Samuel Mazzuchelli labored first among the Indians and traders in the Green Bay region. Later, as Pope John XXIII said, he became “the herald of the Gospel” in the Upper Mississippi Valley, building many churches in that tri-state area. He founded the Dominican Sisters of Sinsinawa. Pneumonia from a sick call caused his death at Benton, Wisconsin, where he is buried. In 1993, he was declared Venerable by Pope John Paul II.
